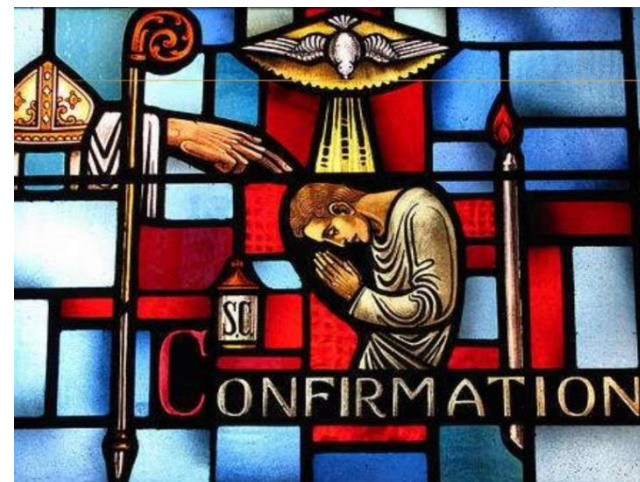
Ascension Day falls this year on Thursday 10 May. The day marks the end of Christ's earthly

It was founded by Queen Victoria in 1896 as a means of recognising service to Royal Family. It has five grades: knights or dames grand cross (GCVO), knights or dames commander (KCVO/DCVO), commanders (CVO), lieutenants (LVO) and members (MVO). The armorial plates of the knights and dames grand cross can be seen on the oak panels on the chapel walls.
